

Henri Giscard d'Estaing, President



Henri Giscard d'Estaing is the President of Club Med.

Prior to his appointment as the President of Club Med, Henri Giscard d'Estaing served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the company (2002-2005), and General Manager (2001-2002). Beforehand, as from 1997, he was entrusted with the positions of Vice President in charge of Finance, Development and International relations.

In the Danone group, which he joined in 1987, he was successively Development Manager (in particular, he carried out the acquisition of the American group Nabisco's European subsidiaries in 1989), CEO of the British subsidiary HP Food Lea and Perrins and CEO of Evian-Badoit and, lastly, Director of the Mineral waters division.

He began his career at the Cofremca, from 1982 to 1987, where he was a Partner specialized in the study of food consumption changes and their consequences in terms of marketing and strategy.

Henri Giscard d'Estaing was born in 1956. He is a graduate of the Paris Institute of Political Studies and has a master's degree in economic sciences.

Henri Giscard d'Estaing serves on the Board of Directors of the Casino Group, Guichard-Perrachon since 2004 and is a member of the Randstad Supervisory Board since August 2008.

Henri Giscard d'Estaing served a mandate as General Councillor of the Loir-et-Cher (French department) and was on this occasion the youngest General Councillor in France.

He likes nature and gardens and practices skiing and windsurfing. He is married and the father of three children.
